Particularly you can find more information about the launch of the Digital Story Board and Online Game exclusively designed, developed and launched by the Halt4Kids project consortium.




Digital Story Board (Billy's Big Secret) & Mobile/Online Game (Peaceful Pines)

We are excited to announce the launch of Peaceful Pines, an interactive serious game developed under the H4K Project. This innovative tool is designed to educate and empower child athletes aged 9-12, promoting safer sports environments through awareness and informed decision-making.

About Digital Story Board - Billy's Big Secret

The digital story board focuses on increasing the knowledge of child athletes for harassment and abuse in sport, by creating scenarios for child athletes aged 5 to 8, along with short readable and audible text.









The characters in the digital story are presented as animals and the title is "Billy's Big Secret". It presents cases of harassment and abuse in sports in child athletes to promote awareness in athletes and also mobilize and sensitize the public about this, as well as to support the whistleblowing of harassment and abuse in sports in these ages.

About Mobile/Online Game (Peaceful Pines)

The game aligns with the H4K Project's mission to enable knowledge sharing and develop best practices in child athlete safeguarding. By fostering awareness and practical skills, the game, titled as 'Peaceful Pines', equips young athletes (of ages 9-12) to build confidence and resilience while encouraging sports stakeholders to create safe, inclusive spaces.



The game takes young players on a journey where they learn to:

- Identify Trusted Adults: Recognize who they can turn to for support.
- Recognize Safe and Unsafe Situations: Understand how to assess their surroundings.
- Learn Boundaries and Consent: Build confidence in setting personal limits.
- Report Inappropriate Behavior: Take actionable steps when encountering unsafe situations.

Through these missions, players navigate real-life scenarios, making decisions that help them understand harassment, abuse, and how to protect themselves in a supportive and engaging way.

HALT4Kids Launches New Safety Apps: PAIR & GUARDIANS

HALT4Kids consortium is excited to share the launch of two cutting-edge mobile applications designed to enhance safety in sport for children and young athletes: **PAIR** - **HALT4Kids** and **GUARDIANS** - **HALT4Kids**.



- PAIR HALT4Kids empowers children to send real-time alerts when they feel unsafe—whether at school, in sport environments, or during everyday activities.
- **GUARDIANS HALT4Kids** allows parents or trusted adults to pair their app with the child's using a unique code and instantly receive location-tagged notifications when assistance is needed.

Together, these apps form a responsive alert system that allows families and caregivers to act swiftly and confidently in safeguarding their children from harassment and unsafe situations.

At HALT4Kids, we believe that digital tools can play a transformative role in building safe, inclusive, and supportive spaces in sport.



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RELATED NEWS FROM PARTNER COUNTRIES

Catalonia Unites to Protect Children: New Safeguarding Network Launched

On May 7th, the Catalan Network for Protection and Good Treatment of Children and Adolescents was officially launched — a powerful initiative led by **FEDAIA**, with the support of **Educo ONG**. This milestone comes in response to a pressing need: in just four years, more than 3,000 cases of violence against minors have been reported in Catalonia, with 25 new cases each week.

The newly formed network aims to become a central hub of support and coordination for child-focused organizations across the region. It will:

- Support and guide organizations working with children
- Promote safe environments and good treatment practices
- Advocate for the real implementation of LOPIVI (Spain's child protection law)
- Collect and monitor rights violations through a dedicated digital channel

Already 12 organizations have joined, with more set to follow — laying the groundwork for a united, region-wide safeguarding strategy.

At **HALT4Kids**, we wholeheartedly support this mission. Our project complements these efforts through digital storytelling, interactive games, mobile apps, and training resources that empower families, coaches, and professionals to recognize, prevent, and respond to abuse in sport. Together, we're building safer environments for children — in Catalonia and across Europe.
